### **Q & A 105**

#### **Q What is God's will for you in the sixth commandment?**

**A.** I am not to belittle, insult, hate, or kill my neighbor—not by my thoughts, my words, my look or gesture, and certainly not by actual deeds—and I am not to be party to this in others;^1

rather, I am to put away all desire for revenge.^2

I am not to harm or recklessly endanger myself either.^3

Prevention of murder is also why government is armed with the sword.^4

and to do good even to our enemies.^3

**Dear partner in ministry,** Thank you for the generous way in which Christian Reformed churches and members are responding to the urgent needs of the people of Haiti. Thank you for caring and thank you for sharing.

I am humbled once again by how the church responds in times of crisis. As of this week, donations to the Christian Reformed World Relief Committee for the Haiti disaster response had already topped \$2.1 million, and the money is continuing to come in, through church offerings and individual gifts, including almost \$700,000 that has been donated online via the "Help Haiti" and CRWRC web sites.

I want to update you briefly on how this money is being used. CRWRC is helping to meet the immediate needs for food, water and shelter by distributing tarps and rice, beans, and pasta to more than 1,100 families in the Port-au-Prince area. It is also working to provide clean water.

As CRWRC continues its short-term response to the needs of earthquake survivors, it is also gearing up for a multi-year reconstruction program. It has identified six villages in Leogane, an area that was hardest-hit by the earthquake, for the next phase of its work. The response will likely include building temporary and permanent housing as well as helping people to re-establishing livelihoods, providing programs for social needs, forming community groups and caring for children. It will also include rebuilding infrastructure such as wells and latrines.

Please continue to remember Haiti in your giving and your prayers. I am grateful that the Christian Reformed Church has been walking alongside the people of Haiti for more than 30 years. We were there before the earthquake and we will continue to be there long after the world's attention has moved elsewhere, not only ministering to physical needs but reaching out with the gospel through the work of Christian Reformed World Missions and Back to God Ministries International. Thank you for making this possible.
