Message Activation Questions: A Baptism in the Word thru the Spirit:  
A Baptism of Water and Fire

**1. “Lean In” An Introduction Question**

What’s one of the best things in which you have ever been involved? Explain why. *(Think of some activity, experience, relationship, or commitment that has given you a sense of fulfillment.)*

**2. “Look Down” An Observation Question**

As you read Romans 12:1-13, what words or concepts really grab your attention and get you excited? Why? *(Is there a particular verse or phrase that seems to have your name on it? Is there a particular action verb or attribute that fits you and inspires you?)*

**3. “Look Out” An Understanding Question**

Which of the concepts, activities, and attitudes listed in this passage are most needed in our church and community right now? *(Try to explain how things might change or look different, if this or that activity or attitude were consistently put into practice in our church or community)*

**4. “Look In” The Application Question**

On which activity or attitude are you committed to work so that you can be transformed and be a transformer? *(What is that going to look like in you life? What **change** are you **really** willing to make?)*

In Christ, Be Real, Be Free, Be United, Be Involved, so that by the Holy Spirit we will be “Creating Community where lives are fulfilled by following Christ” to the glory of God, our Father.
