

## **“The Heart of Worship is...All About You Jesus”**

Isaiah 29:13 Mark 12:28-34

### **1. Lean In : An Introduction Question**

What are 3 things presently in your life you would hate to give up?

### **2. Look Down: An Observation Question**

As you read over Matthew 12:28-34, what's your instinct as to what the Teacher of the Law was after and what Jesus was after? Where was the Teacher of the Law's mind? Where was his heart?

### **3. Look Out: an Understanding Question**

What captivates the hearts of people today? List some things that people seem “to worship”...things that compete for our love, loyalty, time and resources. Now, which do you believe is harder to do: To Love God with your all, or to love your neighbor as yourself?

### **4. Look In: The Application Question**

“You are not far from the Kingdom of God,” Jesus said to the teacher of the law. How might that be true of some people you know? But, how about you? Where are you with Jesus? Is it “All about You, Jesus” with you?

### **5. Look Right into “The Heart of worship” Bonus Question**

In a Spirit of repentance and truth reflect again on Isaiah 29:13 and on these words Matt Redman wrote in this song: “I'm sorry, Lord, for the things I've made it...” Then honestly ask yourself this: Does my participation in the worship service really contribute to my monogamous love relationship with Jesus? If so, how? If not, Why not and what has to change?
